

## Flash based form not showing up on your computer?

Flash (Flash is used to show the forms on this website) is already installed on over 98% of all browsers including Internet Explorer.

Many websites on the internet have Flash used somewhere within the website... so if the forms on this website are not showing up... the issue may be either fixed by trying the options below.

1. First, click the link below and follow the **Troubleshoot Adobe Flash Player installation for Windows** information. This page will help diagnose and fix many common Flash issues: [http://www.adobe.com/go/tn\\_19166](http://www.adobe.com/go/tn_19166)
2. Second, if your computer has installed any of the “free toolbars” such as Yahoo and Google toolbars or others, they can cause problems with the Flash players within the browsers and create other security risks. You may want to remove the free toolbars to see if this fixes the Flash problems.
3. Next, if you haven’t already checked what version of Flash is installed on your computer or to get the latest version installed on your computer click the link below:

4. Finally, make sure JavaScript is enable on your computer (if you have it turned off):
  1. Go to the **Tools** menu and select **Internet Options...**
  2. In the **Internet Options** window, select the **Security** tab (at the top of the window).
  3. Under the **Security** tab, select the **Internet** Web content zone.
  4. Under **Security Level for this zone:**
    - a. to enable JavaScript:

If there is a slider bar move the slider bar to **Medium**. Otherwise, if the security level is **Custom**:

- i. Click on the **Custom Level ...** button at the bottom of the page to open the **Security Settings** window.
      - ii. In the **Security Settings** window scroll down until you get to the section called **Scripting** (near the bottom).
      - iii. Under **Scripting** there is a category **Active scripting**, select the option marked **Enable** for this category.
      - iv. Click the **OK** button.
5. Click the **OK** button.

These fixes should fix the Flash issue and allow the website forms to show up for you.
